



Abridged Biography | Prof Ronaldo Munck



Ronaldo Munck is Professor of Sociology and Director of the Centre for Engaged Research at Dublin City University and a member of the Council of Europe Task Force on The Local Democratic Mission of Higher Education. Professor Munck was the first Head of Civic Engagement at DCU and drove the 'third mission' alongside teaching and research. As a political sociologist Professor Munck has written widely on the impact of globalisation on development, changing work patterns and migration.

Recent works include *Migration, Precarity and Global Governance*; *Rethinking Global Labour: After Neoliberalism* and *Social Movements in Latin America: Mapping the Mosaic*. He is a member of the editorial board of the following international journals: *Globalizations*, *Global Social Policy*, *Global Discourse*, *Global Labour Journal*, *Latin American Perspectives* and *Review: Journal of the Fernand Braudel Center*. He is a lead author of Amartya Sen's International Panel on Social Progress Report 'Rethinking Society of the 21st Century'.
