Functions of the Committee

- Share best practices in waste management and recycling.
- Source model business cases for new technology.
- Report on sustainability practices.
- Advocate for best practice.
- PLAN
- Two-day colloquium.
- Establish common targets and measurements.

Way forward:

- The universities need to have representation on each subcommittee.
- A high-level steering committee, composed of the executive management, needs to drive the agenda.
- Meet at least twice a year, to monitor progress.
- The 'HESCOP' to consider partnering with organisations such as SARU, DST, USAf, SARIMA, etc.
- Create awareness at our respective universities.
- Review the terms of reference.
- Change the existing name.
- Involve DHET and USAf as the direct stakeholders - each must have a representative.
- Create a steering committee that will meet on a regular basis.
- University representatives to influence VCs and VPs.
- Unisa will be retained as CoP administrator.

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
